We're excited to announce that our summer court bookings are in progress. This year, we'll have access to three locations May 12 – October 13. The city has informed us that North Glenmore Park will be resurfaced in June and July. As soon as we receive our permits (beginning of March) we will publish a summer schedule in April, with Open and Level play.
