If you are relying on a Club rating, please make sure to submit evidence of your rating to membership@calgarypickleballclub.ca ahead of the season so we can accurately enter them into the system. New Booking System, CourtReserve



As many of you know, the application we used in 2025 for viewing and registering for play sessions (PicklePlay) is no longer available, and after reviewing several options, the club has decided to move forward with CourtReserve.

Why CourtReserve?

Many members already use it at other indoor and outdoor clubs, which makes it familiar

It is a robust and reliable platform

It allows us to better track usage and participation data

It will allow us to notify registered players of any cancellations

It will automate player check in, wait lists, reminders and more

We also want to give a huge thank you to Rob Puls for collecting open play participation data over the past several years. It has been a massive effort, and we are excited that this new system will allow him to enjoy the summer more ☀️

📱 What This Means for You

There will be a small change to how open play works:

You will now be required to Register for Open Play sessions in advance on Court Reserve (please create an account prior to start of summer play, on your computer and/or on your phone by downloading the application).

The host will check you in using the app

👉 Training will be provided for both members and hosts, so everyone feels comfortable using the system. **A host training session is being planned for April 26, 2026 – save the date!**
